
## Langport Huish Drove & River Parrett <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Mile (Up to section 1 accessible) Section 2-4 Moderate 1.5 miles

Description: This walk consists of two parts; the riverside section is suitable for persons of all abilities including wheelchairs and scooters. The riverside has seating suitable for disabled walkers and there are toilets and a café in the adjacent car park. The section along the opposite side of the river is level but very uneven and not suitable for wheelchairs and scooters. Cocklemoor Car Park has free parking (TA10 9PG).



- 1. From Cocklemoor car park proceed along the tarmac path to the river, turn right and proceed along the gravel path to the bridge. There are several bench seats along this stretch of river.
- 2. Cross the bridge to the Levels Basket Centre, turn left, follow the path to the gate and bear left along the rough track, there are many potholes in this section and muddy when wet.
- 3. Proceed along the track, cross the bridge and turn left back onto the opposite riverbank. The river bank path can be very muddy in places and suitable for moderately fit persons.

4. Follow the line of the river bank and you will return to car park access path.
